#### **Review of Weed Management in NSW**

The Natural Resources Commission (NRC) released a draft report in February outlining findings and recommendations for its review of weed management in NSW. The draft report has been informed by research, consultation and over 200 public submissions in response to the initial issues paper that was released in October 2013. After consultation on the draft report, the final report will be prepared for the Minister for Primary Industries by late May 2014. On behalf of all members, the Weed Society of NSW sent in a submission with all recommendations supplied by our members. Thank you to all members who participated in this review.

## **Weed Society of NSW Travel Study Grants Applications close on 1st June 2014**

Applications are invited for attending national or international conferences, or for specific overseas study tours of a short duration. Applicants must be over 18 years old, reside in New South Wales or the ACT, be involved with weed research, management, advisory, regulation or practice, and have been a current member of the Society for at least one year.

Grants will be made by 1st July for travel during the following 12 months. Applications for awards or grants to attend a conference are expected to be supported by an abstract of the paper being presented. On return, successful applicants are expected to provide a report to the Society for publication in A Good Weed. Application forms at: SocietyTravel Grant.

### **Weed Society of NSW Website Report**

The majority of visitors first accessed our website via the homepage. The conference page was the next most popular starting page (thanks largely to the links on the conference website), followed by the student page. Publications and contact us also were important first points of contact.

Ninety percent (90%) of all visits were from Australia, with the United States, the United Kingdom and India being the most dominant of the 22 foreign countries. Seventy seven percent (77%) of Australian visitors were from NSW, with Queensland and Victoria being the best represented of the other states and territories.
