
Happy new year and welcome to the 11th edition of the Punnet Tray.

#### **CAWS Travel Awards**

Australasian Weeds Conference Travel Award: This award is Intended to support people currently working with weeds who CAWS consider would most benefit from attending the conference but who would be unlikely to attend for financial reasons without assistance from this award. Early Career Weed Scientist Travel Award: Applicants must have, at the date of application, completed their last degree (undergraduate, Master, PhD or other postgraduate degree) within the last five years. Applicants should also have commenced employment in any branch of weed science. 
