### **Medal for Excellence in Weed Management**

**Closing Date: Friday 8 September 2017** 

The Medal for Excellence in Weed Management is a prestigious award given periodically by the Society to recognise the sustained and influential contributions made by an individual to weed management in New South Wales.

The Award is open to anyone in New South Wales who has made an outstanding contribution in the technology or practice of weed management. The contribution can be based across several categories such as research, teaching, administration, regulation, extension, commercial, or implementing programs. The awardee's contribution must be recognised by peers as exemplary and must have an impact on the work of others and sustained over a substantial period

Nominations received will be treated confidentially by the Awards Committee. The committee will consider the nominations and inform the executive committee of the successful nominees. The Executive Committee will consider the recommendations of the Awards Committee and make the final decision.

The Award is an inscribed medal plus a framed citation signed by the President and will be announced by the Society's President at the Annual General Meeting/Annual Dinner or other special event.

The Awards Committee is calling for nominations from Society members with a closing date of **Friday 8 September 2017**.


